## How to use the button configurator:

- 1) Download Rhino 7 or newer.
- 2) Download the button configurator.
- 3) Open buttonconfigurator.gh.
- 4) The current status of the button is visualized in Rhino.
- 5) Configure your button by using the sliders on the left of the script.
  - 1) Decide on a radius & thickness (in mm).
  - 2) Decide on a hole amount and their position and hole diameter
  - 3) Decide if you want a recession, if so decide on a radius and depth. They are in relation to the base button.
  - 4) Decide if you want a chamfer or a fillet, decide on their size (in mm).
- 5) Right click on the FilEdge tool on the right of the script. Use the command "bake".
- 6) Export the button in Rhino.
- 7) 3d print the button.
- 8) Attach it to your garment.
